On August 21-23, 2008, *The Twentieth International Congress of the Jangjeon Mathematical Society* (of which Professor Hari M. Srivastava is a past president) was organized in Karinna Hotel at Mount Uludağ. The refereed proceedings of this congress were published in *Advanced Studies in Contemporary Mathematics* and *Proceedings of the Jangjeon Mathematical Society*.
